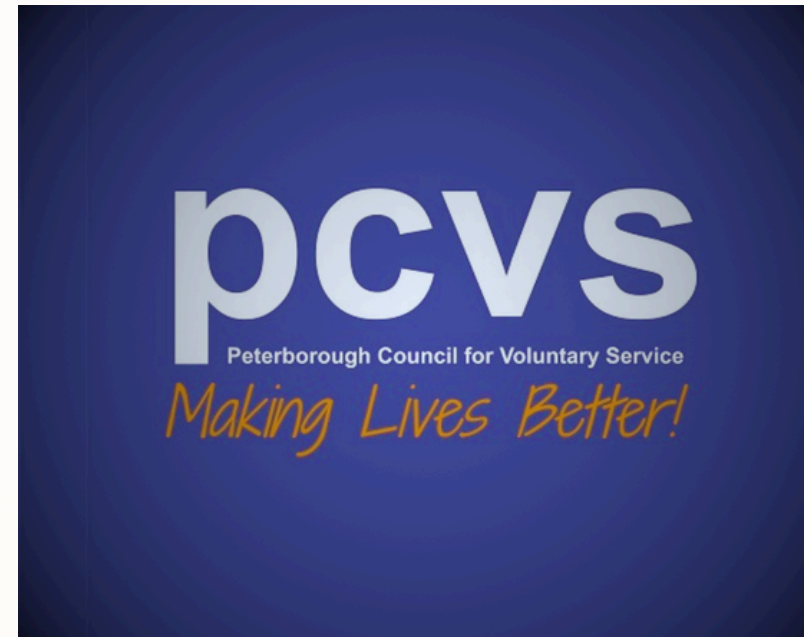

Representation & Advocacy

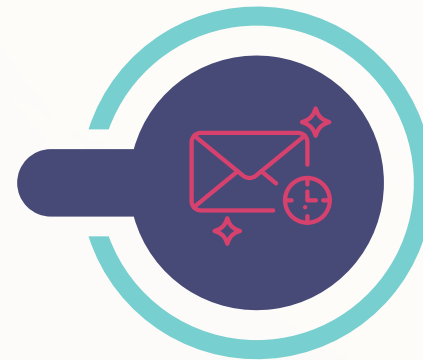
PCVS attends a wide range of stakeholders groups and boards, ensuring that the voluntary sector is valued and recognised for the work they do and that their voice is heard.

Digital Inclusion Support

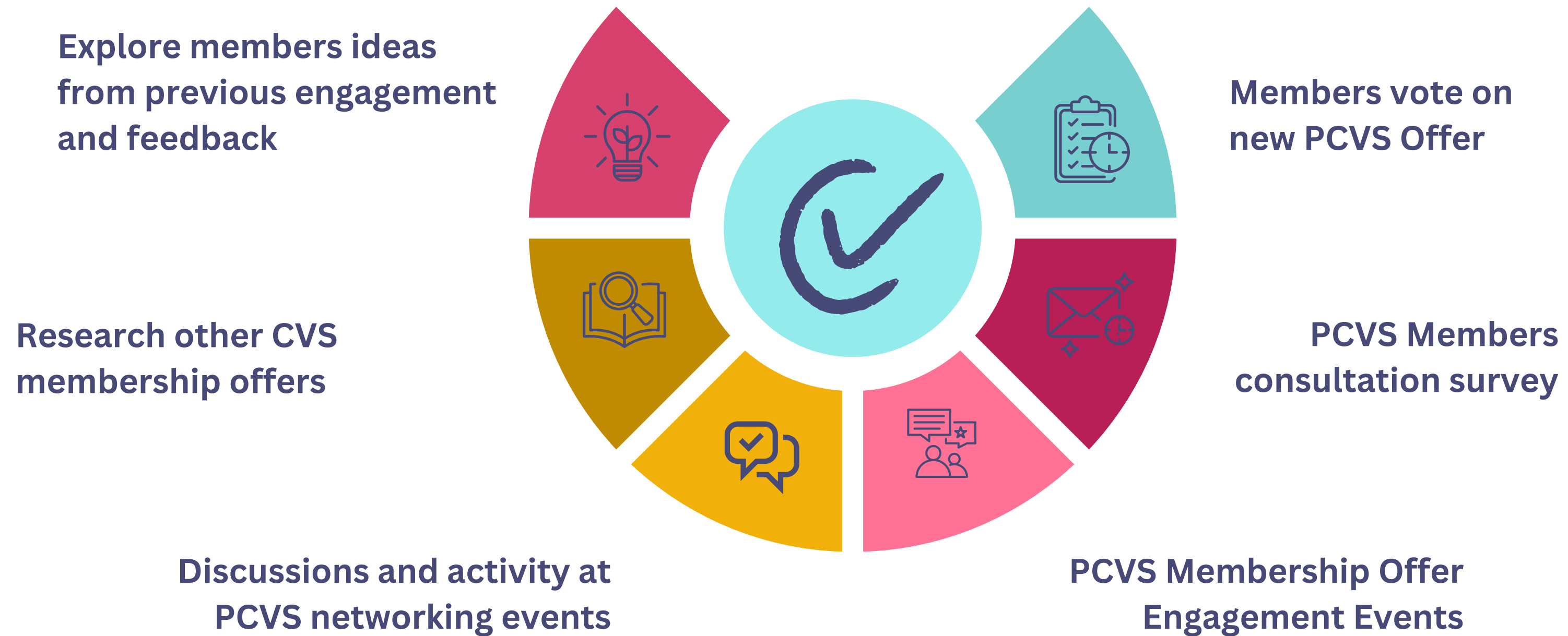
A forum/network alongside a delivery project that supports the growth and development of digital inclusion within charities and voluntary groups.
